- The only way to reverse an opiate overdose is to administer NALOXONE?
- You can be trained to administer this life-saving medication?

The goal of REVIVE! is to save lives by reducing the number of deaths resulting from opioid overdose emergencies by providing Lay Rescuers, with the knowledge necessary to respond to an opioid overdose.
